

ISEA ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP INSTRUCTIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

Who is Eligible: All current ISEA members in good standing except the following: Scholarship Committee Members, Board Members, Collaborative Members (unless such Collaborative member has an individual membership in addition to being part of the Collaborative) and Previous Scholarship Winners within the past three (3) years.

Entry Dates: 12:01 AM **July 1**, through 11:59 PM on **July 15 of the current calendar year**

Application Requirements:

- Provide a Word document (not a PDF) with a maximum of 350 words answering the following questions (1 – 5) and save it with your name in the file. Example:
VanGogh_Vincent_ScholarshipStatement.docx
 1. What does experimentation in your art mean to you? (20 points)
 2. How do you experiment now and what do you want to do differently? (20 points)
 3. Describe the challenges you are trying to overcome. (20 points)
 4. How would the scholarship further your experimentation? (20 points)
 5. Provide the name of the instructor, workshop/course work, dates, and cost (20 points)
- Submit an image of your current work with your name and the image name in the file: Example:
VanGogh_Vincent_Starry Night.jpg
- Submit a headshot or photo of yourself with your full name in the file: Example:
VanGogh_Vincent_Headshot.jpg

Submission Requirements:

Send your completed Word document, your photo, and the photo of your work attached to an email to scholarship@iseartexhibit.org during the required entry dates.

For Scholarship Recipients - The Recognition and Promotion Process Requirements:

The scholarship recipients must provide a brief summary (200 words) for the website and the October newsletter detailing what they learned, or intend to learn, and how they found value from the opportunity.
